WOTC Update – Urgent Notification and Action Required National Youth Self-Attestation Form

The Department of Labor has issued updated guidance in connection with the Disconnected Youth Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) category. TALX wants to alert you that a new version of the declaration will be required for submission to the WOTC State Offices. The Department of Labor has issued a newly released National Youth Self-Attestation Form replacing any previously released Disconnected Youth declaration or other types of self-attestation forms. Important information released from the Department of Labor impacting your WOTC practices follows in this bulletin.

Applicants must screen using the May 2010 National Youth Self-Attestation Form

August 23, 2010:

WOTC State Offices require May 2010 National Youth Self-Attestation Form

The May 2010 National Youth Self-Attestation has been incorporated into the TALX electronic screening methods, including Interactive Voice Response and web-based applications.

The Department of Labor clarified the instructions for sending the National Youth Self-Attestation Form to the states. Best practice is still that you submit the form along with the IRS for 8850.
